Mixed Review of Short & Long Vowels

Parents: Students have to be able to decide if a vowel is short or long when they spell a word.

When you have a vowel-consonant-e pattern, the e is silent and the vowel makes its long sound.

The vowel makes its short sound when it is in a closed syllable. A closed syllable ends in at least one consonant making the vowel short.
